FINANCIAL AIDS AND GRANTS

Every academic year, the Rinaldi Foundation allocates a budget item for grants, and study aids in order to facilitate access to studies for those who need it.

COLLABORATION GRANT:

It consists of an economic endowment aimed to complete 150 hours of collaborative work in any of the departments or services of EUSS along the academic year.

DOMÈNEC SAVIO GRANT:

Students with experience in service to society can apply for this scholarship, which is the result of merging a Study Aid grant and a Collaboration grant. It is aimed to complete 150 hours of collaborative work within the Pastoral Animation Team throughout the academic year.

STUDY GRANT:

This scholarship consists of a direct discount on tuition fees for students with a good academic performance (25% discount on the price of the credit).

DON BOSCO GRANT:

Aimed at students who have completed the studies that give access to EUSS in a Salesian school. This grant enables students to study the degree at public price, with the commitment to perform 200 hours of collaborative work in a department or service of EUSS.

Students are eligible for both Student Aid and Collaboration grants simultaneously. Furthermore, all of our grants are also compatible with other tuition deductions, as well as with the general grant the at the Ministry of Education/AGAUR.
